JOB DESCRIPTION

GREENSKEEPER I
Job Description Code – 6000d

This position will be responsible for performing any combination of the following duties to maintain grounds and turf of golf course in excellent playing condition. Essential duties/responsibilities of the Greens Keeper:

Key duties/responsibilities for this position but not limited to:

- Mow rough and fairway areas at designated cut, exercising care not to damage turf, flowers, or shrubs
- Cut turf on green and tee areas, using hand mover, walk behind power mower and/or Triplex.
- Dig and rake grounds to prepare new greens, grades, and clean traps, and repair roadbeds using shovels, rakes, picks and spades and other tools
- Plant, trim, prune shrubs by use of trimmer, gas blower and hedge trimmers
- Arrange pins and tee markers for tournaments per Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent's direction.
- Maintain clean, working tools and machines
- Renovate worn and damaged turf
- Participate in maintenance staff and safety meetings as required.
- Perform various duties assigned by Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent or Greenskeeper Foreman

Physical Demands: This position requires large physical demands. This employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and use hand to handle and operate objects, tools or controls. Lift or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and move more than 100 pounds. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb; balance; stoop; kneel; crouch; or crawl. Must be able to handle working in extreme weather conditions from cold to hot. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, ability to adjust focus, color vision, peripheral vision, and depth perception.
