JOB DESCRIPTION

IRRIGATION TECH / GREENSKEEPER II

This position will be responsible for performing any combination of the following duties to maintain grounds and turf of golf course in excellent playing condition.

Key duties/responsibilities for this position but not limited to:

- Operate various tractor and machines, using specific attachments, to till, cultivate, and grade new turf areas.
- Apply prescribed amounts of lime, fertilizer, insecticide, and fungicide by using a backpack sprayer.
- Mow rough and fairway areas at designated cut, exercising care not to damage turf, flowers, or shrubs.
- Cut turf on green and tee areas, using hand mover, walk behind power mower and/or Triplex.
- Plant, trim, prune shrubs by use of trimmer, gas blower and hedge trimmers.
- Arrange pins and tee markers for tournaments etc.
- Maintain a healthy turf by aerating, topdressing, rolling and verticutting.
- Maintain clean, working tools and machines.
- Renovate worn and damaged turf
- Dig and rake grounds to prepare new greens, grades, and clean traps, and repair roadbeds using shovels, rakes, picks and spades and other tools.
- Assist superintendent with preventative maintenance of irrigation systems.
- Connect hose and turn on sprinklers systems at designated points on course to irrigate turf.
- Check irrigation system for leaks, lakes, and dry areas.
- Repair existing underground sprinkler systems including malfunctioning heads and nozzles.
- Ability to operate equipment such as trenching and digging tools and other related grounds/landscape equipment.
- Understand the rules related to golf and know how to measure green speed and interpret the results
- Participate in maintenance staff and safety meetings as required
- Perform various duties assigned by Superintendent or Greenskeeper Foreman

Physical Demands: This position requires large physical demands. This employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and use hand to handle and operate tools or controls. Lift or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and move more than 100 pounds. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb; balance; stoop; kneel; crouch; or crawl. Must be able to handle working in extreme weather conditions from cold to hot. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, ability to adjust focus, color vision, peripheral vision, and depth perception.
